With the right laser, all common tattoo colors can be removed; black and dark tones, blues and sky blues, reds and tans, and greens.

Laser affects the tattoo with very short and strong laser pulses that penetrate deep into the skin, without injuring the top layers. These pulses are then absorbed by the pigments in the ink which breaks them up into smaller particles. These are then naturally absorbed by the body's own immune system.

People who have had tattoo removal by laser say that it feels like a rubber band snapping the skin. The number of treatments depends on the size of your tattoo as well as its location, depth and color. Amateur tattoos are the easiest to remove whereas professional ones may require more treatment sessions. The tattoo will fade slowly between treatments as your body removes the remainders of the tattoo pigment.
